About the June Roper Sporting Trust

June Roper MBE was born in Melton in 1924 and played and coached tennis and badminton in the local area for more than 68 years.

June became Hamilton Tennis Club's first female club captain and represented the Club at numerous tournaments.

She was an enthusiastic supporter of young players and in 2010 launched a primary school tennis project run by club coaches which resulted in 12 local schools receiving free coaching throughout the summer and winter.

How to apply

June combined her sporting pursuits with an enormous amount of charity work. In 2005 her hard work for Macmillan Cancer Support and other causes earned her an MBE in the Queen's birthday honours list.

In her Will, June kindly made a donation to her local Building Society's Charitable Foundation. June had a long standing relationship with Melton Building Society and trusted the Society's Charitable Foundation to administer her legacy wisely. In line with her wishes, the Charitable Foundation has set up a special trust – the June Roper Sporting Trust – to ensure June's legacy supports charities or nonprofit making organisations or individuals with a focus on sport.

How to apply Like many other Trusts, we receive many more applications than we can fund. The Trust will only support charities or non-profit making organisations or individuals with a focus on sport.

Please write a letter, no more than two sides of A4, telling us the following details:

- 1. Your name or the name of your organisation** – what you do and how you will benefit from the Trust's support;
- 2. Funding** – why you need funding, details of the project and approximate funding requirements;
- 3. Location** – we will only support requests that fall within Melton Borough catchment area (see map opposite).

All letters are studied by the Administrator and at least one Trustee who determine the outcome of your proposal. Please be aware it may take up to 2 months to get back to you with the outcome, which will be one of the following:

- 1** Your application is unsuccessful – unfortunately, the Trust receives many more requests for funding than we are able to support and we regret

that we have to turn down many good proposals even though they meet our criteria. We are sorry but it is therefore not feasible to give feedback as to why a proposal was unsuccessful.

- 2** Your application was successful, and you will receive a small award, of up to £500.
- 3** Your proposal will be discussed at the next Trustee Meeting, and a meeting arranged to find out more about your organisation, with a view to a larger grant being awarded. Please note, even if your proposal goes before the Trustees, there is no guarantee of success.



Summary Privacy Policy

Melton Mowbray Building Society Charitable Foundation takes your privacy very seriously and always treats your personal details with the utmost care.

This Privacy Policy explains the types of personal data we collect, what we do with it, who we share it with, how long we keep it and your rights.

If you have any questions about the data that you share or we collect, don't hesitate to get in touch. We'll be more than happy to help.

We promise to keep your information safe and secure.

Personal information we collect from you

This will depend on the nature of any request you make to the trustees and the Community Foundation, but can include (but is not restricted to):

Identity details which includes your full name, title, date of birth, age, unique personal identifier and account number

Contact details which includes your home address, email address and phone number

Personal information about your family which includes your marital status, next of kin, dependents and emergency contact details

Profile data about you which includes your sex, occupation, employment status, citizenship status, residential status, property details, occupancy status and insurance information

Identification data which includes your driving licence, passport, National Insurance number and other national identifiers

How you interact with us which includes call recordings or any other form of communication.

Personal information we collect from others

Sometimes we work with carefully selected third parties and charities and we may receive your personal information from them.

Purposes of the processing

Data protection laws require us to explain what legal grounds justify our processing of your personal information (this includes sharing it with other organisations).

For some processing more than one legal ground may be relevant (except where we rely on a consent). Here are the legal grounds that are relevant to us:

Processing necessary to perform our charitable objectives, including providing financial support to claimants

Where we consider that, on balance it is appropriate for us to do so and the processing is necessary as a result of the legitimate interest which apply to us and in some cases other organisations

Processing necessary to comply with our legal obligations

Processing with your consent

Processing for a substantial public interest under laws that apply to us where this helps us to meet our broader social obligations.

Sharing your personal information

Where necessary, we may ask to share your personal information for marketing purposes – i.e. on our website, social media pages and/or on our internal intranet. This will be to promote the work of the Charitable Foundation, and we will always ask for your consent prior to any publication.

Keeping your personal information

We keep personal information for as long as it is required by us:

To manage our relationship with you and provide charitable support

To communicate information about your request

To administer the Foundation's finances including any request for funding
